2. All applications for scholarships must be received by the administrator by May 1st for acceptance for the Fall semester. No late applications will be accepted. Applicants will be notified by email of their acceptance status for the scholarship by July 1st. Awardees must supply a copy of their tuition bill to the administrator of the fund at least three weeks before the due date. The checks issued by the fund must be paid to the educational institution directly.
3. The Williamson Family takes an active interest in each of the students and their ongoing studies and accomplishments. It is requested that all recipients send an update at the end of each semester sharing with the trustees their academic standing and personal experiences at the end of each semester. Details of this requirement will be provided to scholarship recipients. Scholarship recipients will be required to reapply each year using a simplified application. Acceptance and scholarship amounts are not guaranteed for future years.
